Planning & Curriculum Development

The Lead Instructor will work as part of a team with the EYS Executive Director (ED), Program Manager, community partners, and two support staff to implement Entrepreneurial experiences with a hands-on focus.

Initial deliverables will include a curriculum for a Monday-Wednesday, forty three-week program, and desired experiential learning partnerships for "push-out/pull-in" activities. Final deliverables will include daily lesson plans in line with curriculum with required educational materials, partnership programs, and student and program assessment criteria.

The YEP Instructor will work with the ED to procure all identified required educational materials and contract with partnership programs within the program budget.

Instruction

The YEP Instructor will be responsible for teaching all areas of the Entrepreneur curriculum to the students. The Instructors will lead the support staff and will jointly be responsible for:

- Organizing classroom and learning resources to encourage a positive learning environment
- Preparing and presenting lessons that cater to the needs of the ability range within the class;
- Motivating pupils with enthusiastic, imaginative presentation

- The Lead Instructor will be responsible for the on-going assessment of student progress and making program design changes as needed.
- The Instructor and Support Staff will work throughout the program with the parents to communicate student successes and challenges and to increase parent engagement.
- •Communicate regular feedback about student progress; maintain open and timely communication with program manager and executive director regarding any concerns or highlights.
- Maintain an engaging classroom environment that consistent to Eastside Youth Strong Mission and goals. Keeping activities hands- on learning and active engagement as much as possible
