



Trauma Informed Substance Abuse Group Facilitator Job Description

Are you an enthusiastic skilled group facilitator who is passionate about helping men in recovery? Douglass Community Association is looking for you!

Group Facilitator Job Description: Group facilitator delivers the Substance Abuse Men's Trauma Recovery and Empowerment Model (SA-M-TREM). Douglass Community Association provides the curriculum for the facilitator to teach and training to ensure quality and consistency in delivery. Each group (2-24 sessions) will require 2 hours of instruction every week. The Facilitator will also be required to attend training meetings, provide feedback about program implementation, and be evaluated.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Ensure that Substance Abuse Men's Trauma Recovery and Empowerment Model (SA-M-TREM) is delivered professionally and effectively to meet desired learning objectives.
- Arrive punctually to site and expertly manage time during the course of the groups to ensure that all aspects of the curriculum are delivered.
- Relate to participants about their recovery and history of traumatic experiences.
- Collect data from pre and post tests and feedback from participants.

Experience Requirements

- Must have experience working in the field of substance abuse, preferably working with men.
- Must have an MSW, (SPADA certification preferred).
- Must have experience working with individuals who have trauma in their history.
- Must have a familiarity with Douglass Community Association, Northside neighborhood.
- Must have experience in working with low income population – must be a diversity minded individual.

Desired Personal Qualities:

- Patience.
- Good sense of humor.
- Strong sense of presence in a group setting.
- Enthusiastic and objective-oriented presentation style.
- Passion for helping low-income men, who are in substance abuse recovery.
