



## **Psychologist--BCBA**

Kalamazoo Community Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services is seeking a Board Certified Behavioral Analyst Psychologist who has experience working with individuals of diverse racial, ethnic, and cultural backgrounds. The successful candidate will complete psychological and functional assessments including testing and treatment recommendations which promote individuals with intellectual disabilities to lead full and inclusive lives within their communities. The candidate will have a full understanding of ABA treatment and will be able to guide and direct ABA treatment. The Psychologist is also responsible for the development, evaluation, and monitoring the effectiveness of behavior support plans and guidelines for youth needing ABA treatment and those with aggressive behavior. In addition, the Psychologist provides consultation and training to providers of service and function as a member of interdisciplinary teams. Part time qualified candidates will be considered. Minimum starting annual salary for a full time employee is \$51,069.

A Master's Degree in Psychology or related field is required, along with a minimum three years experience in a clinical setting with individuals with Intellectual Disability, including those with co-occurring mental health conditions. Knowledge of Gentle Teaching and training in behavior analysis are preferred. Basic computer skills are required. Required licenses include: valid Michigan Motor Vehicle Operator's license and current licensure in the state of Michigan as a Licensed Psychologist (LP) or Limited Licensed Psychologist (LLP).
