Qualifications:

High school diploma or equivalent, with a minimum of one course that earns college credit in child development or early childhood education. Ability to obtain a Child Development Associate (CDA) credential within 24 months from date of hire. Knowledge of and/or experience with pre-school children and the ability to work with children of all abilities. Ability to communicate with adults in a professional work setting is necessary. Embraces and supports KRESA philosophies related to diversity, inclusiveness and anti-racism. Ability to interact effectively with individuals from a wide range of cultures. Ability to discuss cultural differences with colleagues and clients. Ability to assess ones own strengths and limitations or challenges and integrate this understanding into interpersonal interactions.
