Collaborate with administrators and teachers to develop a plan for integrating technology into standards-based curriculum designs. Model the integration of technology into classroom instruction. Identify the best technology tools for integrated learning projects; facilitate and guide students and staff in the successful completion of integrated learning projects with the enhanced use of technology. Promote the use of online and innovative curricular resources for teachers and students. Coordinate professional development for staff which focuses on the integration of technology to improve teaching and learning. Create technology training and tutorial materials. Monitor the use of instructional technology to ensure that resources and activities enhance the district's curriculum and mission. Make improvements to the district's instructional technology program by communicating regularly to staff and administrators about current research-based evaluation and implementation focused on instructional technology resources and best practices. Assist in the creation and management of new technology learning initiatives. Remain current in the instructional technology profession through participation in professional associations (RITS and KRESA Instructional Technologist team meetings), conferences, research, and publishing. Promote the need and growth of the instructional technology position among our constituent districts. Follow regulation and professionalism when working with confidential data. Minimum of three years classroom teaching experience, including demonstrated success of technology integration. Ability to discuss cultural differences with colleagues and clients.
