Explains the purpose and processes regarding the use of assistive technology in schools to school personnel and parents. Works with teachers and support staff in providing appropriate technology and educating the staff and parents regarding use of equipment. Prepares/suggests data collection to use in determining the effectiveness of communication systems. Other duties as assigned.
