Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

Provides instruction to ensure that each student makes progress toward individual stated goals using multisensory strategies and varied teaching techniques by performing the following duties: Plans curriculum and prepares lessons and other instructional materials according to achievement levels of students. Provides direct instruction and supervision of students within school/community setting. Confers with parents, administrators, testing specialists, social workers, and others to develop individual educational programs for students who are at different learning ability levels. Attends MET, IEPT and/or IFSP meetings. Instructs students in academic subjects, utilizing various teaching techniques. Instructs students in daily living skills required for independent living and economic self-sufficiency such as hygiene, safety, and food preparation. Observes, evaluates, and prepares reports on progress of students. Meets with parents to provide support and guidance in using community resources. Administers and interprets results of ability and achievement tests. Assists in the supervision of ASD paraprofessionals. Other duties as assigned.

Minimum Skills and Education:

Bachelor's degree. K-12 Michigan Certification; Autistic Impaired Endorsement. Embraces and supports KRESA philosophies related to diversity, inclusiveness and anti-racism. Ability to interact effectively with individuals from a wide range of cultures. Ability to discuss cultural differences with
